From 27 December Reading Buses is taking over Green Line 702 from First. All existing season and period tickets will still be valid and, for now, the timetable will stay broadly the same, although all London bound journeys will run 5 minutes earlier to make sure we don't run late leaving London.

Because we're not taking over the previous fleet of buses, for the next 8-9 months we will be using a mix of suitable vehicles from the existing Reading Buses fleet which have high back coach-style seats and some temporary vehicles hired in, including a small number of full-specification coaches.

looking forward...

We have ambitious plans to develop the route and will be evaluating a number of new vehicle types during January and February 2018, with a view to ordering a brand new fleet of modern coaches.

We'll also be watching closely over the coming months to see how the current timetable performs, how good the fares are, and see what opportunities there are to market and improve this useful service to increase use and make it a success for the long term.

Most importantly, we'll be listening to you, our customers. Thanks in advance for your custom and being understanding while we find our feet with this new venture and trial options to suit your needs for the future.





Windsor

Windsor is a great place to visit any time of the year, an attractive riverside town overlooked by the royal castle that's stood there for 1,000 years.

It's the largest occupied castle in the world and has been the family home to British kings and queens for all of that time. Ten monarchs are buried in St George's Chapel.

In the magnificent State Apartments you'll find some of the finest works of art from the Royal Collection, including paintings by Rembrandt, Rubens and Canaletto.

You can also see Queen Mary's Dolls' House, created in the 1920s and filled with thousands of objects made by leading craftsmen, artists and designers of the time.




The Old King's Head in Church Street is one of the oldest Inns in Windsor with bags of charm. Nell Gwynne, favourite mistress of Charles II, lived nearby in Burford House.

There are cobbled streets and little alleyways to discover and beyond the historic core are many more interesting streets with fine examples of Georgian and Victorian architecture, particularly south of the Castle toward the Long Walk.

You could take a guided tour in an open-top bus from outside the Castle. Get a ticket (it lasts all day) and you can get on and off the bus at several stops around the town.

You might prefer to enjoy a relaxing river tour, or even an amphibian Duck Bus tour. It's all there in Windsor.



Or pop over the bridge to discover the charms of Eton, home to the famous school, and with a high street lined with a range of independent retailers.



Reference to Concise Biog. Charles the First. AD 1648.

At the head of the River Thames is the town of Windsor, which has been the residence of English monarchs since the days of King Alfred. Small groups of people had settled around a small fortification on the site of the present castle, and in 1066 William the Conqueror built a wooden fortification on the site. This was replaced by a stone castle in 1070, and in 1087 it was destroyed by fire. It was rebuilt by King Henry I, and in 1100 King Robert Curthose, Duke of Normandy, was buried in the church of St. George. The castle has been the residence of English monarchs ever since, except for a short period of 15 years during the Commonwealth. The castle is now the home of the Royal Family, and the Queen's official residence in England.

Legoland



Although younger children will absolutely adore LEGOLAND Windsor Resort, there's plenty to amuse and delight people of all ages.

Sail through uncharted waters and make a splash, set sail on a perilous swashbucklin' adventure to Pirate Shores, or battle your way through an ancient land in search of hidden treasure.

Miniland, made from nearly 40 million pieces, recreates scenes from the USA and Europe, all bustling with sounds, traffic, trains and boats.



Enjoy the thrills of roller-coasters like the Dragon and the Dragon's Apprentice, and go on interactive adventures including Laser Raiders, Coast Guard HQ and the Lego City Driving School.

Green Line drops you off right by the main entrance, and go to legoland.co.uk to check opening days, times and special events.



If the thrill of the turf gets you going, you'll love a day at the races at Ascot, one of the world's most well-known racecourses and home to famous Royal Ascot and the Ascot Gold Cup.

There are four enclosures at Royal Ascot, each with its own individual character, and all put you at the heart of the racing action.
