

ELLSWORTH W. ALLEN TOWN PARK

45 Motor Avenue, Farmingdale

Route 135, Seaford Oyster Bay Expressway to Exit 7E (NY24, Hempstead Turnpike, East). Turn right onto Merritts Road, then proceed under railroad bridge. Follow approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to Motor Avenue. Turn left, proceed to Park on the left.

JOHN J. BURNS TOWN PARK

4990 Merrick Road, Massapequa

Route I 35, Seaford Oyster Bay Expressway to Exit I E (Merrick Road, East, last exit). Continue on Merrick Road approximately 2 ¹/₂ miles. Park entrance is on the right. *Additional parking at Marjorie R. Post Community Park, Unqua Road. A free shuttle bus will be provided from additional parking lots to events.

SYOSSET-WOODBURY COMMUNITY PARK

7800 Jericho Turnpike, Woodbury

Route 135, Seaford Oyster Bay Expressway to Exit 14E (NY25, Jericho Turnpike, East). Proceed East to second light. Park entrance is on the right.

PLAINVIEW-OLD BETHPAGE COMMUNITY PARK

175 Washington Avenue, Plainview

From the North - Long Island Expressway to Exit 46 (Sunnyside Blvd.), toward Plainview. Keep right at the fork and continue toward Executive Drive. Make a slight right at the South Service Road. Turn left at Washington Avenue. From the South - Route 135, Seaford Oyster Bay Expressway to Exit 9 (Plainview Road) toward Plainview. Continue to Manetto Hill Road.
