Guidelines for Use


The Empire Pass decal permits unlimited vehicle access to most facilities operated by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation and the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (see the enclosed listing).

Please review the following rules to assure uninterrupted use of your Empire Pass.

- The **EMPIRE PASS** decal is valid from the date of purchase through March 31 of the year printed on the decal. There is no discount if purchased in later months.
- To avoid misplacing the **EMPIRE PASS** decal, affix the decal to the vehicle promptly after receiving.
- The EMPIRE PASS decal is not refundable, not transferrable and not replaceable if it is lost or if non-receipt is not promptly reported to the office where it was purchased.
- Access is allowed for the decaled vehicle only.
- The EMPIRE PASS decal does not guarantee free vehicle entry into the park when special events occur and are operated by other organizations.
- The **EMPIRE PASS** decal does not include waiver of fees for camping, golf, museum or historic site admission and other special activity fees are not included.
- The EMPIRE PASS decal is only usable for passenger vehicles. It is not usable for commercial vehicles including, but not limited to, buses, RVs/ motorhomes, taxis or any vehicle with commercial license plates.
- The **EMPIRE PASS** decal must be permanently affixed as described below. It will not be accepted if it has been altered in any way or is adhered with tape.
 - Car -- driver's side window, front or rear.
 - Motorcycle -- left side; prominently displayed.


• **Boat** -- for use at boat launch sites, the **EMPIRE PASS** decal must be affixed to the vehicle towing the boat, NOT to the boat. For island parks, where the boat is the primary vehicle which will occur a fee to enter the facility, the Empire Pass decal must be displayed inside of the hull in a protected, but visible area.

- Clear protective covers for permanently affixing
 EMPIRE PASS decals to motorcycles or boats
 without windshields are available free of charge
 upon request.
- Replacement **EMPIRE PASS** decals for sold, stolen, destroyed or damaged vehicles may be issued in person or by mail and requires:
 - A completed *Empire Pass Replacement Request* form.
 - The decal, or its fragments or scrapings (whenever possible, but always for a vehicle that has been sold or a leased vehicle that has been returned); and
 - Proof of loss, sale or damage acceptable to the Office, such as a police report, insurance report, repair invoice, DMV report, bill of sale, etc. whenever possible, but always when the decal or fragments are not available.
 - Leased and rental car users must affix the **EMPIRE PASS** decal and may obtain a free replacement as described above.
